## The Direct Debit Guarantee

- This Guarantee is offered by all banks and building Societies that accept instructions to pay Direct Debits.
- If there are any changes to the amount, date or frequency of your Direct Debit Geological Society will notify you 10 working days in advance of your account being debited or as otherwise agreed. If you request Geological Society to collect a payment, confirmation of the amount and date will be given to you at the time of the request.
- If an error is made in the payment of your Direct Debit by Geological Society or your bank or building society, you are entitled to a full and immediate refund of the amount paid from your bank or building society.
  - If you receive a refund you are not entitled to, you must pay it back when Geological Society asks you to.
- You can cancel a Direct Debit at any time by simply contacting your bank or building society. Written confirmation may be required. Please also notify us.

## Information from The Geological Society about Direct Debit payments we will collect for your 2016 renewal

- If we receive your completed Direct Debit Instruction by **20 October 2015**, your first payment will be collected on or shortly after 1 November 2015. You can choose to pay in one, two or four parts.
- If you choose to pay in two or four parts, your second payment will be collected on or shortly after 1 February 2016. If you are paying in four parts, subsequent payments will be collected on or shortly after 1 May 2016 and 1 August 2016 respectively.
- The last date on which we can accept Direct Debit Instructions for 2016 fees is 19 April 2016. If we receive your Instruction between 1 December 2015 and 19 April 2016, you will not be able to pay your 2016 fees in two or four instalments. (We will be happy to set up payment in instalments for future renewals.) Your full payment for 2016 will be collected on or shortly after the collection date indicated below:

To ensure your fees can be paid by instalments, please make certain your completed Direct Debit Instruction is received at Burlington House as soon as possible.

Please note that Direct Debits can only be set up for UK Bank/Building Society accounts.
