

## Earth Science Week 2023 Geoscience Everyday Competition



### Terms and conditions

1. The competition is open to all.
2. Entrants can submit as many entries as they wish, electronically, in colour or black and white.
3. Media also submitted to other Geological Society competitions are allowed.
4. Media previous submitted to Geological Society competitions are allowed, provided they haven't featured as winners.
5. Each entry should be marked with name, address, and title of the piece.
6. Each entry should also include a short description highlighting the way in which the submission meets competition guidelines as stated in the Geological Society Earth Science Week Geoscience Everyday Competition webpage description [www.geolsoc.org.uk/geocomp](http://www.geolsoc.org.uk/geocomp).
7. Entries should be emailed to [outreach@geolsoc.org.uk](mailto:outreach@geolsoc.org.uk), subject heading 'Geoscience Everyday Competition.'
8. Media can be in landscape or portrait format and be produced using any phone, camera or recording device. Media that is not digital in its original form will be judged based on a digital copy (no matter the form), but if exhibited will be displayed in full form.
9. There is no minimum resolution required, however, poor quality could naturally affect the feasibility of displaying work if your entry is successful. Therefore, we recommend a resolution of 300dpi, which is the minimum required for a quality print.
10. The competition opens at 9:00am on Thursday 8th June 2023 and closes at 23:59pm on Monday 21<sup>st</sup> August 2023.
11. Three people will be awarded first, second and third prizes of £150, £100 and £50 respectively.
12. All entries must be the original work of the entrant and must not infringe the rights of any other party. The entrants must be the sole owner of copyright in all

photographs entered and must have obtained permission of any people featured in the entries or their parents/guardians if children under 16 are featured. Entrants must not have breached any laws when taking their photographs or videos.

13. All entries must be the original work of the entrant and under no circumstances should media be generated via platforms that utilise Artificial Intelligence technologies.
14. Entrants will retain copyright in the work that they submit.
15. The Geological Society reserves the right to crop/resize images and videos if necessary for exhibit display purposes.
