### **Update on Read and Publish Agreements**

#### **Jisc agreement for UK HE institutions and agreement with CAUL for institutions in Australia and New Zealand**

These 2021 agreements are an important route to ensuring authors funded by [Plan S](#) signatories are able to publish in GSL's portfolio.

The agreement is a "Read & Publish" transitional agreement for the Geological Society's Lyell Collection providing read access to 14 journal and book sites, including all current and archived journals plus key book

series and historic collections. The agreement also covers unlimited **Open Access** (OA) publishing of all article types in 6 hybrid journals and 3 hybrid book series. In practice, this means that in 2021 any corresponding author in an opted-in institution will be able to publish on an OA basis in any of GSL's hybrid journals and books for no extra cost at the point of acceptance. #### **Online First for Memoirs**

In January we launched a new feature for our Memoir authors: *Online First*. This is offered through the Geological Society's content platform, the **Lyell Collection**, which enables book articles to appear online soon after they have been accepted for publication and ahead of publication of the final volume. Our authors of articles in Special Publications will be familiar with this feature, but it is new to Memoirs. It will mean that authors whose chapters have been accepted, copyedited, typeset and corrected in advance of other chapters within the same Memoir need no longer wait for all parts of the book to be ready before publication online.

Memoir 55, *Volcanism in Antarctica*, is the first book to offer this feature.

#### **Open Athens WAYFless URLs**

For those of you who are set up to log into the Lyell Collection via OpenAthens, we are pleased to announce that it is now possible to set up WAYFless URLs for your institution. The generic string to use is:

<https://openathens-sp.highwire.org/session/init?entityID=https%3A%2Fidp.eduserv.org.uk%2Fopenathens&hw-shib-return-uri=https%3A%2F%2Fwww.lyellcollection.org%2F&subcode=lcgsl>

Where entityID can be replaced with any IDP's entity ID, hw-shib-return-uri can be any URL on any of the Lyell Collection sites and the subcode should always remain the same. Note that it is the parts after the = and

before the next & that get replaced i.e. {entity} and {target} as per this pattern:

<https://openathens-sp.highwire.org/session/init?entityID={entity}&hw-shib-return-uri={target}&subcode=lcgsl>

Once you have set up this, please contact us so that we can then map your OpenAthens ID in this new part of our access system.
